

Tunghai University Incentive Regulations for Excellent New Students Enrollment

Approved at 2nd Administrative Meeting on January 22, 2013

Article 1 In order to encourage and to enable the students with great performance to enroll at the School, Tunghai University Incentive Regulations for Excellent Undergraduate Enrollment are hereby particularly stipulated (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”).

Article 2 The Incentive objects hereunder include:

1. New bachelor’s students recommended by Multi-Star Project, through individual application or entrance examination enrollment distribution.
2. New master’s general students admitted through allowable admissions.
3. New doctoral students admitted through allowable admissions.

Article 3 Tuition and fees prescribed herein refer to the standard tuition and miscellaneous fees charged by the School excluding accommodation fees, student safety insurance premium, language internship fees, computer / Internet fees, fees for each department’s professional guidance and other collection charges.

Article 4 The new bachelor’s students recommended by Multi-Star Project or through personal application for distribution and have enrolled at the School, whose total score of General Scholastic Ability Test reaches high standard (or higher) shall be granted an award according to the following criteria.

1. Where a total score of General Scholastic Ability Test reaches 70 points (or higher), in addition to the scholarship of NT\$150,000, an extra amount of NT\$100,000 for the first year tuition and fees, NT\$20,000 for accommodation and an amount up to NT\$50,000 for an overseas study round-trip airfare shall be granted.
2. Where a total score of General Scholastic Ability Test reaches top standard (or higher), an amount of NT\$60,000 for the first year tuition and fees, NT\$10,000 for accommodation and an amount up to NT\$40,000 for an overseas study round-trip airfare shall be granted.
3. Where a total score of General Scholastic Ability Test reaches high standard (or higher) with 20% of student intake to enroll at each Department, who have the same results and again have the same results after comparison according to the “Reference for Priority Selection upon Same Results” (at least 3 items) provided by each Department, an extra number of winners shall be approved to increase and granted NT\$60,000 for the first year tuition and fees.

Article 5 The new bachelor's students admitted through entrance examination and have enrolled at the School shall be rewarded in accordance with the following standards. Cumulative percentage of examination results of the specified courses shall be subject to the "Designated Subjects' Cumulative Table of Combinations Scores and Number of Participants" promulgated by Distribution Commission for University-Entrance Exams.

1. Where the cumulative percentage of examination results of the specified courses is in the top 3%, in addition to a scholarship of NT\$150,000, an amount of NT\$100,000 for the first year tuition and fees, NT\$20,000 for accommodation and an amount up to NT\$50,000 for an overseas study round-trip airfare shall be granted.
2. Where the cumulative percentage of examination results of the specified courses is in the top 10%, an amount of NT\$60,000 for the first year tuition and fees, NT\$10,000 for accommodation and an amount up to NT\$40,000 for an overseas study round-trip airfare shall be granted.
3. Where a student admitted to the department as top priority with 20% of actual student intake to enroll at each Department whose results reach the Department's incentive standard (provided by each department) and have the same results and again have the same results after comparison according to the "Reference for Priority Selection upon Same Results" (at least 3 items) provided by each Department, an extra number of winners shall be approved to increase and granted NT\$60,000 for the first year tuition and fees.

Article 6 The scholarship of NT\$150,000 referred to in Article 4 and Paragraph 1 of the preceding Article shall be issued in the enrolled semester under the lump sum grant, and tuition and fees and accommodation shall be paid in installments in each semester; subsidies to overseas study round-trip economy class ticket shall be limited to those participating in sister schools student exchange program, dual degree programs and admitted by sister schools, and shall be reimbursed upon actual cost payment depending on various types of subsidies.

Article 7 The first year scholarship of NT\$100,000 shall be granted to the student admitted through the School master's recruitment selection or entrance examination and officially accepted and ranked the first place and has enrolled at the School. Nonetheless, the number of students recommended by the Department (institution) shall be limited to one without filling vacancies in case of separate group recruitment conducted by the Department (institution) holding selection test and entrance examination.

Article 8 The first year scholarship of NT\$50,000 shall be granted to the bachelor's student approved to take pre-master's program courses according to the School Directions for Students' Five-Year BA-MA Program, new master's general students admitted through allowable admissions and have enrolled at the School (including overseas students).

A student who also meets the application eligibility referred to in the preceding Article may select one to apply for subsidies instead of reapplications.

Article 9 The first and the second year scholarships of NT\$100,000 shall be granted to the new doctoral student admitted through allowable admissions and have enrolled at the School (including overseas students).

Article 10 After the enrollment, the list of the new students who meet the eligibility criteria shall be submitted to the Office of Student Affairs by Office of Academic Affairs. Except for the overseas study round-trip airfare, the subsidies may be issued and granted in installments after being reviewed and approved by the Scholarship Committee within two months after enrollment; any occurrence of frauds and forgeries will lead to a revocation of the student's incentive eligibility and the rewards shall be taken back.

Article 11 A new student who meets the eligibility criteria shall automatically lose his/her eligibility if he/she takes action to retain the admission, suspension or drop out of school. Those granted scholarships shall be taken back.

The granted scholarships due to force majeure or special causes shall not be subject to the preceding restrictions after the review and confirmation of the Committee.

Article 12 The Regulations shall be implemented after being adopted by Administrative Meetings.
